•	I am responsible to find a substitute caretaker to replace me temporarily or permanently on those occasions when I can no longer perform as the caretaker for my colony (i.e. should I go out of town on a trip, should I be temporarily disabled, or should I move away so that I am unable to continue my care taking) (check or initial)
•	I am responsible to keep records for the cats in my colony, including rabies certificates (check or initial)
•	I am responsible to make reasonable efforts to prevent cats from bothering human neighbors, including personally addressing any concerns voiced by my neighbors about the colony cats (check or initial)
•	I am responsible to make every effort to ensure that all cats in my colony (including new cat arrivals) are vaccinated against rabies, and spayed/neutered, and ear-tipped (check or initial)
•	I am responsible to provide food, water, and shelter for my colony (check or initial)
