TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN WORKSHOP

Community Cats Maryland offers a free educational workshop where you can learn about trap-neuter-return (TNR), feral cat management practices, local resources for feral cat spay/neuter, and proper use of a humane trap. It's also a great way to meet and network with other local cat caretakers, or to get started with us as a volunteer.

The workshop is held the third Thursday of every month at 7 PM at BARCS, the Baltimore city animal shelter, located at 301 Stockholm St. (right near M&T Bank Stadium). The workshop usually lasts about 90 minutes, and there are plenty of opportunities to ask questions. No registration is required, just show up!

The shelter is closed to the general public at 6 PM on weekdays. If you arrive early for the workshop and the main entrance is closed, ring the doorbell at the animal surrender entrance and someone will let you in and show you to the lobby.

Directions to BARCS

From I-95 North: Take exit 52 toward RUSSELL STREET NORTH. Merge onto Russell Street. Take the third right onto WORCESTER ST. Go one block, turn left onto WARNER ST. Then take the next right onto STOCKHOLM St. The shelter is the first building on the right.

From I-95 South: Take exit 55 toward FORT MCHENRY NATIONAL MONUMENT/KEY HWY. Stay straight onto E. McCOMAS ST. Turn right onto MD 295/S. HANOVER ST. Turn left onto OSTEND ST. Just before going under the overpass by the stadium, turn left onto S. SHARP ST. Cross the railroad tracks and turn right onto STOCKHOLM ST. The shelter is the first building on the left.

From the Inner Harbor: Go south on LIGHT ST. Turn right onto OSTEND ST. Just before going under the overpass by the stadium, turn left onto S. SHARP ST. Cross the railroad tracks and turn right onto STOCKHOLM ST. The shelter is the first building on the left.

From the Hanover St. Bridge: Go north on HANOVER ST. Turn left onto OSTEND ST. Just before going under the overpass by the stadium, turn left onto S. SHARP ST. Cross the railroad tracks and turn right onto STOCKHOLM ST. The shelter is the first building on the left.

Public transportation: The shelter is .4 miles from the Hamburg St. light rail station at M&T Bank Stadium. It is .6 miles from the Charm City Circulator purple route stop at Marshall St. and E. Ostend St. Nearby MTA bus stops: Charles St. and Ostend (.6 miles, bus lines 1 and 64), Russell St. and Worcester St. (.3 miles, bus lines 14 and 27).
